


**LINDOP SCHOOL DISTRICT 92  
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REDUCTION OF  
CERTAIN FUND LEVIES FOR THE 2019 LEVY YEAR**

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2019, the Board of Education of Lindop School District 92, Cook County, Illinois ("School District") did adopt a certificate of tax levy for the 2019 levy year for subsequent filing with the County Clerk of Cook County ("County Clerk"); and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk has notified each Cook County taxing district which is now subject to the Property Tax Extension Limitation Act ("PTELA") that it may direct the County Clerk's Office, by proper resolution, to make specific and necessary reduction to its tax levy for the 2019 levy year to meet the requirements of PTELA.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Lindop School District 92, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Education hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true and correct and does hereby incorporate them into this Resolution by reference.

Section 2. That the Board of Education hereby authorizes and directs the County Clerk to extend the School District's tax levy for the 2019 levy year in no less than the following amounts as indicated:

**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ESTIMATED AMOUNTS  
NECESSARY TO BE LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2019**

WHEREAS, the Truth in Taxation Law requires that all taxing districts determine the estimated amounts of taxes necessary to be levied for the year not less than twenty (20) days prior to the adoption of the aggregate tax levy of the district; and

WHEREAS, the Law requires that public notice be given and a public hearing be held on the district's intent to adopt an aggregate tax levy in an amount which is more than 105% of the amount extended or estimated to be extended upon the final aggregate levy extensions, plus any amount abated, exclusive of election costs, for the preceding year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education for Lindop School District 92, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The aggregate amount of taxes, estimated to be levied for the year 2019, is \$6,386,653 exclusive of levies for bond and interest and including estimated levies for specific purposes as follows:

Section 2. The amount of taxes estimated to be levied or to have already been levied for bond and interest purposes for the year 2019 is \$439,990.


Section 3. If required, the administration shall cause an appropriate public notice to be published and a public hearing to be scheduled on the levy, such hearing to be held on December 17, 2019, or such other appropriate date as determined by the Board President.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.

## TAX RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Illinois School Code authorizes the Board of Education of Lindop Public School District No. 92 to levy, by proper resolution, special taxes for various purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, LINDOP PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 92, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The County Clerk of Cook County is hereby authorized and directed to extend the following special taxes on behalf of this school district the sum of \$4,883,360.00 as a special tax for Educational purposes, the sum of \$556,774.00 as a special tax for Operations and Maintenance purposes, the sum of \$113,612.00 as a special tax for Transportation purposes, the sum of \$48,663.00 as a special tax for Working Cash purposes, the sum of \$50,000.00 as a special tax for Illinois Municipal Retirement purposes, the sum of \$50,000.00 as a special tax for Social Security purposes, the sum of \$96,244.00 as a special tax for Fire Prevention and Safety purposes, the sum of \$223,000.00 as a special tax for Tort Immunity purposes and the sum of \$365,000.00 as a special tax for Special Education purposes. On the equalized assessed value of the taxable property in School District 92, Cook County, Illinois for the year of 2019.

**Section 2.** The Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.






